

Hull LIFT, Kingston Upon Hull

3e Consulting Engineers is working with the City Care Developments on the Hull LIFT programme that will deliver **state of the art** primary health care facilities across Hull over the next 25 years.

The Government backed LIFT (Local Improvement Finance Trust) operates as a public/private partnership which incorporates the Sewell Group, the UME Group, NHS Hull and Community Health Partnerships.

To date, 3e has been involved in the **construction of six new health centres** across Hull providing GP services and other community facilities.

The pioneering £4m **Longhill Health Care Centre** was the fifth community health centre to be developed by Hull Citycare. The Centre has been designed as a “primary care plus centre” within the City’s health and community infrastructure, and will enable the replacement of four existing single-handed GP practices, along with accommodation for specialist nursing services, minor surgery and allied health professions, as well as some diagnostic testing. A modern library will be incorporated together with an integrated pharmaceutical service.

The structural design delivers **large column-free internal space** to maximise flexibility and a glazed roof lantern is supported by clear span portal frames, allowing day light into the atrium and library below.

The £3.5 million **Park Health Care Centre** was completed in 2007 and provides consulting and treatment rooms for three GP practices, community health and nursing services over the two storey building.
